- ∞ Classes are taught in 4-week series by a licensed Art Therapist
- ∞ The hour-long classes are taught on Saturdays mornings by age group, 4-9 and 10 +
- ∞ Each class is limited to 8 students (including siblings)
- ∞ Activities vary by class, but include painting, clay work & other artistic activities
- ∞ There is no charge for participants, but donations and sponsorship are welcomed.

- ∞ Promote the recreational, therapeutic, developmental and physical benefits of engaging children in art activities
